## **Background**

In Response to and compliance of with the “Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1986, the Wallingford Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) was formed to increase the protection of life and property within the Town of Wallingford. Further, the use, storage, and transportation of hazardous materials in and through the Town of Wallingford and the recognition of that hazard potential necessitate emergency preparedness and response planning. The Wallingford Local Emergency Planning Committee has produced an **All Hazards Emergency Response Plan** that serves as an umbrella for multiple required plans including LEPC, Public Health, and Emergency Management.
