General Statement of Duties: Performs highly skilled tasks in the maintenance, repair and construction of roadways, storm and sanitary sewers, parks, recreation areas and public grounds; operates and may repair any piece of equipment in the department exercising great skill in said operation to the extent of finish grading and other high skills in normal operation procedures; removes snow and ice from Town roads and sidewalks; directs the work of others as assigned; performs aerial work when needed; performs other related work or work of a lesser grade, if required.

Supervision Received: Works under the direction of Superintendent, Foreman, or other authorized supervisor.

Supervision Exercised: By assignment, may direct the work of one or more employees, normally of a lower grade, by assigning tasks, inspecting work or keeping equipment in working order.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Considerable physical stamina to work under arduous conditions; thorough knowledge of processes and materials used in construction and maintenance of roads, parks, recreation and public areas; extensive ability to operate mechanical equipment required in assigned operations; considerable knowledge of maintenance, repair and construction of highway, sewer or park and public grounds projects; ability to work long hours during storms and other emergencies; ability to direct the tasks performed by others and to establish effective relationships with others.

Minimum Qualifications: Five (5) years' experience in a field related to heavy construction of which three (3) years shall have been in a special skill, manual or mechanical OR one (1) year of training in a skilled trade substituted for one (1) year of experience up to four (4) years and one (1) year of construction experience OR an equivalent combination of experience and training.

Special Requirements: Must possess and maintain a valid commercial driver's license (CDL) Class B to operate equipment. A commercial driver's license (CDL) Class A is preferred. Must be available to work nights, holiday, and weekends during snow, ice and /or wind storms, and other emergencies involving the Department of Public Works.

Fringe Benefits: Excellent Health Insurance Packages, Group Life Insurance, Pension Plan, Paid Holidays, Paid Vacations, Paid Sick Leave.
