


Inflow and Infiltration Removal Program



Why did I receive an Inflow and Infiltration (I&I) inspection letter?

- At the time of an ownership change.
- When a building permit is issued for improvements or repairs of buildings costing \$25,000 or more.
- Potential issues were identified during a meter reading or meter replacement.

Inflow and infiltration (I&I) inspections are performed by Wallingford Sewer Division staff at <u>no cost</u> to the property owner to identify private I&I sources of clean water that may be entering the sanitary sewer system such as:

- Sump pumps,
- Exterior roof downspout connections,
- Basement floor drains, or
- Leaking sanitary sewer laterals.

The Wallingford Sewer Division has developed an Inflow and Infiltration Removal Financial Reimbursement Program to assist property owners with the cost of private inflow and infiltration removal from the sanitary sewer.

Beginning July 1, 2025 once a **new** inflow and infiltration (I&I) field inspection is completed and the documentation is recorded by the Water and Sewer Divisions Engineering Section staff, **a** \$50.00 I&I Inspection Credit on a future sewer bill will be issued.

Timber's Corner

Applesauce and Oatmeal Base Recipe for Cut-out Cookies

Ingredients

- 2 cups whole wheat flour
- 2 cups rolled oat flour
- 2 eggs
- 2 tbsp melted coconut oil
- 1 cup unsweetened applesauce
- 1 tbsp vanilla extract

Instructions

- Preheat oven to 350°F
- Combine all ingredients in food processor or stand mixer. Add flour as necessary until dough is no longer sticky and is ready to roll out.
- For different colored dough, divide into separate bowls and add natural food coloring.
- Keep dough covered to prevent drying between batches. You can rehydrate dough with a little coconut oil as needed.
- Bake at 350° for 20 minutes and let cool before serving.

Notes: This dough refrigerates up to a week and freezes for 3 months.

Steps to Avoid Frozen Pipes

- Maintain an interior temperature of at least 55°F
- Repair any broken windows and doors, and insulate walls near water meters and pipes.
- Be sure heat can circulate around meters and pipes.
- Regularly check pipe insulation for dampness. Wet insulation is worse than no insulation at all.



Water Conservation Tips

- 1. Turn off the faucet while brushing your teeth.
- 2. Only run the washing machine and dishwasher when you have a full load.
- 3. Use a low flow shower head and faucet aerators.
- 4. Fix leaks.
- 5. Install a dual flush or low flow toilet, or put a conversion kit on your existing toilet.
- 6. Don't overwater your lawn or water during peak periods, and install rain sensors on irrigation systems.
- 7. Install a rain barrel for outdoor watering.
