

Who Should File: All owners of taxable personal property. Signature Required: The owners shall sign the DECLARATION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY AFFIDAVIT (page 4). The owner's agent may sign the Declaration, in which case the Declaration must be duly sworn to or notarized.

Extension: The Assessor may grant a filing extension *for good cause* (CGS §12-42). If a request for an extension is needed, you need to request the filing extension in writing on or before November 1, 2025.

Penalty for late filing – The Declaration of Personal Property must be signed and delivered or postmarked to the Assessor of this Municipality no later than Monday, November 3, 2025 to avoid a 25% Penalty for failure to file
