The Wallingford Parks and Recreation Department is proud to present the 2025 *Twilight Tunes Concert Series*, taking place on South Main Street.

To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all attendees, and in accordance with Chapter 216 of the Wallingford Town Code, the following road closures and parking restrictions will be in effect on the dates listed below:

South Main Street, between its intersections with Prince Street and Center Street, will be closed to all motor vehicle traffic beginning at 5:00 p.m. Additionally, parking will be prohibited in this area.

Beginning at 12:00 p.m., parking will also be prohibited in front of and directly across from 50 South Main Street and the Wallingford Post Office.

Parking restrictions will be clearly posted in advance. Please note that any vehicles parked in violation of these restrictions will be subject to ticketing by the police and may be towed at the owner's expense.
