- WHEREAS, domestic violence touches every community, regardless of race, religion, or background. Its effects are far-reaching, impacting families, shaping childhoods, and changing lives forever; and
- WHEREAS, this October, the Wallingford Police Department is paying tribute to those who have lost their lives to domestic violence and showing support for survivors in our community; and
- WHEREAS, from October 20 through 24, 2025, the Silent Witness Initiative an emotionally moving visual memorial to victims of intimate partner homicide will be on display at the Wallingford Parade Grounds; and
- WHEREAS, on Monday, October 20, 2025, at noon, the Wallingford Police Department will hold a brief ceremony at the Parade Grounds to lay wreaths in memory of Karizmah and her son, who tragically lost their lives last year in Wallingford; and
- WHEREAS, on Thursday, October 23, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., the Wallingford Police Department will host a "Coffee with a Cop" event in front of Town Hall along with representatives from Meriden-Wallingford Chrysalis. Individuals are encouraged to come together for conversation and support around domestic violence awareness; and
