Bank Robbery in Wallingford

On March 27th 2024, around 1225 hours, Wallingford Police responded to TD Bank (928 North Colony Road) for a reported bank robbery that had just occurred. The suspect fled the scene in a dark colored, four-door, Honda Civic. The suspect remains at large as of this correspondence.

Staff at the bank reported the male suspect passed a note to a bank teller demanding cash, and said he left the bank and entered a dark colored Honda Civic. They described the suspect as a white male with olive complexion wearing a blue surgical mask, black baseball hat, dark sweatshirt, and black glasses on. The male had dark hair and a very scruffy/bushy dark beard on the side of his face. Staff explained that he looked like he was in his late 20's or early 30's and was approximately 5'9". Staff at the bank said he made off with an undetermined amount of cash and that no weapon was used during the theft. Officers descended upon the area immediately and initiated their investigation into the incident.

No injuries were reported and we believe there may have been another person in the getaway car.

The Wallingford Police Department's Patrol and Detective Divisions handled this case.
