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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE APPRO-PRIATING \$125,000 FOR THE DESIGN PHASE OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL ROOF RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF \$125,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN TO MEET SAID APPROPRIATION AND PENDING THE ISSUE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE

Section 1. Section 1 of an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Appropriating \$125,000 For The Design Phase Of The Public School Roof Reconstruction Project And Authorizing The Issue Of \$125,000 Bonds Of The Town To Meet Said Appropriation And Pending The Issue Thereof The Making Of Temporary Borrowings For Such Purpose", adopted by the Town Council on January 10, 1989 and approved by the Mayor on January 17, 1989 is amended by substituting the figure \$340,000 for the figure \$125,000 therein and by providing for the construction costs for the Town-wide school roof replacement program in addition to design costs, thereby making said Section read as follows:

"Section 1. The sum of \$<u>340,000</u> is appropriated for a Town-wide school re-roofing program, including design, engineering, infrared moisture testing, and asbestos testing, and construction costs, at various Town of Wallingford Public Schools, said appropriation to be inclusive of any and all Federal and State grants-in-aid thereof, and for administrative, legal, financing, and printing costs related thereto."

Section 2. The first sentence of Section 2 of said ordinance is amended by substituting the figure \$340,000 for the figure \$125,000 therein, thereby making said sentence read as follows:

"Section 2. To meet said appropriation \$ 340,000 bonds of the Town or so much thereof as shall be necessary for such purpose, shall be issued, maturing not later than the twentieth year after their date."
