Town ordinance 370 appropriating the sum of \$125,000 for engineering fees and miscellaneous costs associated with the replacement of public school roofs became effective February 14, 1989.

The town council transferred the sum of \$15,100 from the 1988-89 general fund contingency account to finance start up costs for the school roof replacement committee and for engineering fees associated with the Stevens Elementary School roof. The costs will be accounted for within the ordinance.
