Dear Council Members:

Statements were made at the last Council Meeting regarding an alleged loss of fill at the 88 South Main St. property and a subsequent purchase of fill. At the meeting on August 6th in the Mayor's office, Bob Avery, John Costello, Steve Deak, Henry McCully, Iris Papale, Dave Dougherty, Bob Parisi, Joan Stave and the undersigned discussed this issue.

The following facts were reviewed:

1. The Town did not dig a new foundation as the property was purchased with the existing foundation of the Davis house which had been moved.
2. Any fill removed from that foundation contained refuse including foundation blocks, roots and other debris bulldozed into the site when there was concern that children might be injured.
3. The fill that was purchased was a grade necessary for backfilling the new foundation.
4. Public Works is providing fill for backfilling the curbing for the new parking lot. It was not established that there was any wrongful removal of fill.

Attached is a complete record of all expenditures and status of the project prepared by the Engineering Department.
