Mr. Langenauer stated that this is similar to Item 4 above. The current Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Town of Wallingford and UPSEU 424 – Unit 17 (Management Unit) provided for an increase of \$3,000.00 plus a 2.00%, salary increase for Calendar Year 2024. However, since the increases were unknown when the Water Division prepared its FY 2023-2024 budget, the salary changes were not included in the budget estimates. As a result, the Water Division is requesting a budget amendment for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 increasing various accounts, as indicated below, which will be affected by the arbitration award as well as a corresponding decrease of \$46,300.00 to the Division's Retained Earnings (Cash).
