53 Therefore, the recent wage increases will become retroactive to January 1, 2024. The
54 Wallingford Electric Division is requesting a budget amendment in the amount of \$75,987.00.
55 The funds will be used for the retroactive payroll adjustment that will be recognized in Fiscal
