Public Works approached the Mayor to approve an RFP to upgrade Dutton Park.

- **Wallace Park Plantings – John Sullivan**

John will start planting next week at Wallace Park. John has a few plant hangers that will go on the pillars. John wants to also get roses for the back fence.

- **Budget proposals/results update – Kenny Michaels**

The new budget will include a new basketball court and two tennis courts at Community Lake Park. Pragemann Park basketball court will also be renovated with ARPA money.

The carpets at the Parks & Rec building are to be replaced. The existing carpets are bubbling because the glue is worn off. New picnic tables are replacing the existing tables at various parks.
