A Special Meeting of the Board of Ethics of the Town of Wallingford was held on Thursday, February 20, 2024 at 6:30 p.m. in Room 315 of the Wallingford Town Hall, 45 South Main Street, Wallingford, Connecticut.

Meeting called to order at 6:35 p.m.

1. Executive Session pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 1-225(f), § 1-82(b) and § 7-148(a) to consider an ethics complaint.

Motion to go into Executive Session as stated in Agenda made by Sean Doherty and seconded by JP Venoit. Unanimous vote in favor of motion.
