The CT Legislature passed \$10 million in grants for trails. Sheila and Mary are meeting with Town Planner Kevin Pagini, Mayor Vincent Cervoni, and others on June 12 to plan grant applications. Kevin Pagini hopes to build trails connecting from the new senior housing project (at the old Choate boathouse) to Hosford St. and eventually to North Plains Hwy. Also, from Hall Ave. to the railroad station, Route 5, and Benhaven School. New grants involve a state bond money fund. We will need to apply for planning grants, one to connect southward to North Haven trails, and another for the downtown connectivity. The federal grant to extend southward required us to front the money and then get reimbursed.
