An upcoming Water Division quarterly newsletter will include our information about dog waste disposal, but it is postponed to the summer issue or later (due to other priority content in the next issues). In the meantime, we can post information on Facebook.

The design quote of \$1,193 was received from Linda at Fossil Graphics for the replacement sign at the Hall Avenue entrance. It will be installed on the existing posts from the old sign. Public Works can install a welcome sign at the Yalesville entrance (352 Main Street); we will consider designs for this at a later date. (The Fireworks Island sign, which was supported by the Community Foundation of Greater New Haven, will be kept but moved to the new trail reroute.)

Amphenol has fulfilled their pledge of \$17,500 matching donation to support our pending federal \$54,000 grant to extend the trail toward North Haven.

Mary spoke with an officer at CT DOT, who suggested we enlarge the project to include a trail route in North Haven (beyond Toelles Road), so it would become a two-town project. Such a project would qualify for an Urban Act grant. A trail in North Haven might go east of the Quinnipiac River, or west of the river, following the mowed edge of Route 15 and connecting to the Banton Street trail in North Haven.
