RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Town of Wallingford has applied for and received a grant for financial assistance under the Open Space and Watershed Land Acquisition Grant Program (OSWA), established and administered by the State of Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection ("DEEP") pursuant to Section 7-131d of the Connecticut General Statutes.

Resolved, that Vincent Cervoni as Mayor of the Town of Wallingford is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Town of Wallingford an Open Space and Watershed Land Acquisition Grant Agreement and a Conservation and Public Recreation Easement and Agreement for property known as 138 Williams Road, Wallingford, Connecticut (OSWA #667) with the DEEP, and to manage said land as open space land pursuant to Section 7-131d of the Connecticut General Statutes.

BE IT FURTHER KNOWN that Vincent Cervoni was elected as Mayor on November 4, 2025 and his term of office began on January 5, 2026 and will continue until January 3, 2028. As the Mayor, Vincent Cervoni serves as the Chief Executive Officer for the Town of Wallingford and is duly authorized to enter into agreements and contracts on behalf of the Town of Wallingford.
