The committee discussed the families' concerns and the Town's requirements and desires to recognize the 100th anniversary of the demise of Major Raoul Lufbery. The families requested permission to place the plaque at the Historical Society, donated by the Lufbery and Stickle families, on property on 180 South Main Street for these reasons: more public visibility and greater security to protect their family investment for the benefit of the Town of Wallingford and the proper military honor. Bob Beaumont discussed with the Town Planner, Kaci Costello, that this proposal satisfies the family's request and town zoning regulations to place the plaque 10 feet behind the property line and 30 feet from center of street.

Bob Beaumont shared the plaque details from the family, which will likely be granite.
