John Rozz at Sound Spectrum has been confirmed as the Disc Jockey for the evening at a quoted cost of \$1200.00. Dawn is in receipt of the contract and will follow up on the deposit and final payment information.


Dawn suggested using the Park and Recreation contracted vendor for the Port O Lets at a current rate of \$80.00 per handicap unit.
