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ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION Staff Report January 2022 Activities Presented at February 2022 EDC meeting

Local Initiatives

- Update from the December report: Proton Therapy Center proposed for Northrop Rd: CON (Certificate of Need) has not yet been rendered by the OHS (Office of Health Strategy) in Hartford. We now anticipate a decision sometime in February. This application has been active for over two years
- The Data Center text amendment proposal allowing this use category in the IX and I5 zones, via special permit, was not voted on at the PZC's January 10th meeting. Driven by the availability of the sound expert, this has been delayed until their April meeting.
- No change from the December report: GotSpace LLC, proposer of large data center projects, has a new COO and is once again actively working to advance their project
- Corporation Council, Town Planner and staff met with representatives from DECD and Advance CT to discuss state-wide data center activity. DECD has received an application for tax exemption from a data center developer and expressed their confidence that this development category is active in CT
- Calare Properties, owners of 5 Research Parkway, met with staff, our Town Planner, and our Town Engineer to discuss possible uses for their 183 acre site. The site is being actively marketed by the international brokerage firm Cushman& Wakefield
- No change from the December meeting: The Town Council voted unanimously to contract UHY Advisors, a national tax and business consulting firm, as our consultants for oversite of the ARPA process. A draft application has been written and will be circulated for revision/refinement. Recommended priorities for first round funding are small business, not-for-profit agencies, and individuals. We're hoping to have an application in the market before the end of Q1 2022
- Staff met with our Superintendent of Schools and several of her staff to discuss their facility needs for the Adult Education Program in the event they relocate to accommodate the adaptive reuse of the railroad station
- The Mayor's scheduled meeting with our legislative delegation fell short of expectations as snow prevented all but Representative Fishbein from attending. Our comments, as approved by the EDC at our January meeting, were directed at mobilizing our workforce

Creating Opportunities

- The appraisal for 25 Wallace Ave (the small parcel behind Center St Brewing Co.) has been completed. The Town Council approved the sales price of \$18,000 for the parcel which was in line with the appraisal. The Law Department is preparing documents that will detail the conditions of sale.
- Chair Mirra and staff addressed the Town Council to ask for their support for the release of an RFP for the adaptive reuse of our historic railroad station. The vote passed 8 to 1, with one councilor expressing concern about the relocation of the adult education program. The RFP was released on 1/21. RFP's will be opened and reviewed on 2/18. Special thanks to our Grants Administrator, Purchasing, Public Works, and Engineering Departments for their active participation in this project
- Staff and the Town Planner met with a large property owner to review the proposed changes in the I-5 zone and how they could impact development opportunities. The Town Planner was open to proposing modest changes suggested by the property owner that meet our goals as a Town and support responsible development opportunities for the property owner
- Staff met with a commercial brokerage firm that specializes in brownfields projects. The focus of our discussions was 80 Valley St, the former Allegheny Ludium Steel plant. We see great opportunity for this 50 acre site but Allegheny has not been willing to sell the property as they are responsible for site clean-up before the title can be transferred. They treat the expense of their property taxes as a cost of doing business as it's much less expensive than cleaning the site. This firm will pursue discussions with Allegheny
- Still being reviewed by the PZC: No change from the December meeting:
 - The PZC's review of the proposed IX and I-5 zone changes remain a work in progress. This
 extensively researched draft document has been collaboratively vetted by our land use
 professionals, the Water/Sewer Division, the Law Department, the Mayor, and the EDC P&Z
 Liaison Committee

Annual Economic Development Commission Update

January-December 2021

January 5, 2022

Dear Mayor Dickinson,

The Economic Development staff actively worked on 95 requests (a 10% increase over 2020) for engagement from local businesses, developers, commercial property owners, commercial brokers and site selectors as a means of supporting our existing businesses and building our business base. To lend perspective, the 95 requests for engagement range from single proprietors looking to open a business to strategic visioning for adaptive reuse of vacant office space to new development opportunities on large land parcels. Economic Development efforts do not differentiate projects by size as every applicant sees their business opportunity as a high priority.

We're fortunate that vacancy rates in our retail spaces, given the gravitational pull of e-commerce, remain favorable when compared to many CT communities. The demand for warehouse space far outpaces our ability to satisfy need with what is now non-existent inventory. Office space vacancy rates will be addressed in a separate portion of this report.

Although our economic activity levels continue to trend positively, several large projects failed to cross the finish line in 2021. Continued economic hurdles driven by extreme workforce shortages, lack of access to needed state resources, and the COVID crisis elongate project timelines by months.

Connecticut has the highest unemployment rate in New England while the workforce participation rate is at a 45 year low. Our businesses are facing alarming staffing shortages! We have driven dialog regarding this issue at local, regional, and state economic development meetings throughout the year. Government must respond with decisive actions!

Transition

After thirty plus years of service to the program planning office we said farewell to EDC secretary Lynn Wolff as she entered retirement. Lynn was a fantastic resource in our office and graciously remained on staff well beyond her announced retirement date to assist in the transition to our new staff secretary Stacey Hoppes.

Business Activity Data

The economic development office tracks electricity connects and disconnects using data provided by our Electric Division. This methodology is not a perfect science but is an indicator for new business starts and closures. 2021 saw a disproportionate number of small business disconnects at 103. New business electrical connections show 45. Data derived from the Secretary of the State shows 192 new LLC's established in Wallingford in 2021. The net effect is a gain of 90 businesses for the year. The caveat worthy of mention is that the State data reflects many home based businesses, thus we're trading bricks and mortar operations for home based businesses...not a good dynamic. We also saw nine business expansions and six business relocations.

Proton Beam Therapy Center

Pursuit of this significant opportunity for our Town has been an arduous journey that began in **August of 2019**. A formal decision from the Office of Health Strategy (OHS) in Hartford is expected by mid-January 2022.

Comments are contingent upon OHS approval

This project goes beyond economic development as proton beam therapy is the most advanced cancer treatment available today. Presently, cancer patients prescribed this treatment have to go to New York or Boston. Wallingford will have the first and only facility in the state. There is another proton center proposed in Danbury whose application is roughly one year behind ours.

This \$72 million project is fully taxable (both real and personal property). In addition to monetary growth, this unique medical use adds a state of the art element to our grand list, an objective highlighted in our Plan of Conservation and Development (POCD). Economic multipliers realized by having this treatment center in town are not immediately significant but are not to be dismissed. Meetings have been held with commercial landlords in the area to explore other future medical uses that may benefit by being in proximity to the proton center in hopes of adding other taxable development opportunities.

Data Center Development

The EDC has been pursuing data center development opportunities for many years recognizing their low infrastructure impact, environmental friendliness, market sustainability, benefit to the Wallingford Electric Division and significant contribution to the modernization of our grand list. Although the State Legislature passed a tax exemption for data center development projects that exceed \$200 million in private investments, (legislation we collectively supported), municipalities stand to gain monetarily via municipal host agreements. For example, the data center project proposed by Gotspace LLC could generate 2.5 times the taxes we presently receive from our industrial parks on a per-acre basis...a multiple we will not likely see from any other use category.

Staff worked confidentially with a site selector beginning in 2019 to identify prospective development sites. Over the following 18 months purchase and sale agreements were signed creating the possibility of two data center campuses. The approval pathway included a host agreement approved by the Town Council and a power purchase agreement approved by the PUC. The PZC is scheduled to vote on language that would allow data center development in our IX and 15 zones at their January 2022 meeting.

It has been a long haul as complications within Gotspace LLC temporarily halted their project plans but Gotspace LLC is now again active and in pursuit of project opportunities. The EDC remains highly confident in the market opportunity that exists along the I-91 corridor for data center development and thus strongly recommends that our Town be diligent and purposeful when development opportunities arise.

5 Research Parkway

Bristol Myers Squibb left Wallingford three years ago. The 183 acre site, by far the largest single development site in Town, has been returned to raw land as the 1 million square foot BMS facility was razed. In September, Amazon's application to build a 219,000 square foot warehouse and distribution facility was denied by the PZC which resulted in an appeal by the applicant that has since been rescinded.

The site is again for sale or lease unencumbered by the previous purchase and sale agreement. Given the large scale opportunity this presents for our Town, we are working with Calare, (the property owner), DECD, and Advance CT (CT's economic development entities) to find the highest and best suited use/user for the site. Conversations with our Town Planner have given us refined direction while pursuing allowable uses for this site because it's in our Watershed Protection area.

Secretary of the State

CT Economic Developers have been urging the Secretary of the State's (SOTS) office to provide new business start-up data for over five years. The SOTS office is the only place all businesses must register as it is where they receive proper licensing. The data was made available to us in January of 2021 but fell to the wayside by mid-year due to difficulties incurred when SOTS implemented technology upgrades that have proven to be problematic in many ways.

The data we received showed a significant trend towards home-based businesses, a trend that we'll watch when the data is made available again. The home-based business trend is having a negative impact on small commercial space leasing and will likely become a PZC issue at some point as business uses in residential zones could be challenged by neighbors.

The Office Market

We continue to experience a Class A office vacancy rate near 25%! Our vacancy rate was slightly lower than that when we had one million square feet vacant at Bristol Myers Squibb. The BMS inventory has been removed from the list because the facility has been razed, yet the vacancy rate has gone up. As we know, this is not a problem unique to Wallingford. Facilities have been evaluated to determine whether they are suited for adaptive re-use. Unfortunately, many are not. The largest industrial office space brokerage firms in the country are working to re-invent office spaces. It will take time...upwards of a decade in some cases. We're experiencing grand list erosion because partially tenanted or vacant office buildings have a lower market value.

By the time this report is released, we hope to be sharing good news about a significant office user relocating to Barnes Park North.

Planning with our land use professionals

The EDC had identified additional development opportunities in our IX and I5 zones several years ago. Namely, reducing the open space requirement in our IX zone (now 50%) and adding additional uses in the I5 zone. Turnover in the Town Planners office had slowed the process but we are now back on track. The EDC, Town Planner, Public Utilities, Law department, Town Engineer and the Environmental Planner have collaborated on zoning documents that fulfill our visions for responsible development opportunities while protecting the beauty of our industrial parks and protecting our watershed. We hope to see the adoption of new regulations before the end of Q2, 2022.

Town Center Development: Historic Railroad Station/Wallace Ave/Outdoor Dining/Train Noise/Parking

Our strategic vision of enhancing the lower portion of our Town Center is taking shape as we finish 2021 with momentum in the pursuit of an adaptive re-use project at the historic railroad station. We plan to present our vision to the Town Council in January 2022 and ask their support for sending out an RFP for major building upgrades and exterior landscaping improvements. Visions of a "high foot traffic" use for this unique building give us confidence that this will help encourage investment in surrounding properties...we

will be leading by example. The strategic purchase of the former Brother's Restaurant property helps provide the necessary parking for the project and future development opportunities in the area. We must move deliberately so we can apply for a CT Communities Challenge Grant in April 2022.

The EDC supports the sale of a small parcel of land (presently owned by the Town) behind 25 Wallace Avenue. This parcel can be used to improve the experience hundreds of people enjoy each week at the Center St Brewing Company. In addition, several Town departments worked with Mr. Vincenzo Dinatale to surmount the many hurdles he encountered regarding the demolition and rebuilding of new rental units on Wallace Avenue. The results will be a great improvement to the area.

People like dining outdoors! Town departments engaged with many restaurants throughout Town for the second consecutive year to help sustain their businesses by supporting outdoor dining. Simpson Court presents a unique set of circumstances because the outdoor experience spills into a Town owned parking area. This area became the "spirit of Wallingford" as capacity crowds dined and danced throughout the week. We strongly recommend the continuance of this great experience and applaud the Mayor for his past support.

We continue to wrestle with the annoyingly loud horn noises coming from the trains as they travel through our many at-grade crossings. We are grateful that our law department has been aggressive in pursuit of a solution that may include a quite zone designation. There's no assurance of mixed use development projects in our lower Town Center once the noise issue is addressed but we've spoken with several developers that will not pursue opportunities due to the present noise issues.

After almost 20 years of controversy over the status of the parking lot between Simpson Court and Holy Trinity School, the lot is freshly paved and lined. The EDC, along with several other Town departments, argued successfully about the economic benefit that quality parking has on our ability to attract commerce and build upon our brand as a destination for dining. Two parking lots on Wallace Avenue have been approved for improvements as well. Our vision is to have our newly improved parking areas aligned electronically with restaurant websites so when destination diners click on directions to a restaurant they will be directed to these improved lots.

23 South Colony St

The retail plaza at 23 South Colony St along with several store fronts on Quinnipiac St were purchased by Carl Davia, an investor from North Haven. Mr. Davia razed a blighted building while making immediate improvements to what had become a very unattractive portion of our lower Town Center. The plaza and adjoining store fronts are now fully occupied for the first time in over a decade. The EDC worked in harmony with other Town officials to reach a settlement on blight fines that were inhibiting the property's transition to the new owner. An outdoor dining area is planned for opening in the spring of 2022.

Electronic Marketing Initiatives

After a seven month project with a hand selected group of very talented students from Quinnipiac University, our digital channel strategy was poised for launch. The EDC's marketing committee thoroughly researched and actively debated whether a digital marketing strategy could enhance our ability to market Wallingford within CT and beyond. Our new website landing page and presence on LinkedIn and Instagram are supported by email marketing campaigns. Our goal of hiring a part-time staff person to focus on the many opportunities a digital presence can have was thwarted when we were unsuccessful in attracting the

right skill set. Our limited digital marketing presence is being handled by current staff. A larger opportunity still remains.

New Town Planner

There's no one office in Town government that EDC staff interacts with more than the Town Planner's office. We welcomed Kevin Pagini as our new Town Planner and have wasted no time in establishing an excellent working relationship. We give kudos to Kevin, as we have for his predecessor Kacie Hand, for his open door policy and willingness to engage in conversations with the EDC, prospective businesses and developers. We further wish to extend appreciation to interim town planner Tom Talbot for his stewardship during the transition process.

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 is the sixth largest COVID-19 relief bill passed in the last year and is by far the largest infusion of federal resources to the State of CT. Wallingford will received \$13 million from the State's allotment. The EDC, in conjunction with the Mayor and other Town departments, is formulating a strategy to use a portion of the money to assist small businesses that have been negatively impacted by the COVID crisis. We are currently progressing through draft versions of an application with a goal of having said application in the market place by late Q1 of 2022 and relief monies in the hands of distressed businesses in Q2 and Q3.

Departmental Cooperation

Capitalizing on development opportunities is to a great degree contingent upon cross-departmental cooperation. The EDC quite proudly salutes and thanks the Town Planner, Town Engineer, Law Department, Public Works, Building Official, Public Utilities officials, Assessor's office, Health Department, Chief of Police, Fire Chief and Fire Marshal, for always engaging with a singular phone call. This level of cooperation sets Wallingford apart from many CT communities. We extend our appreciation to the Mayor for his ongoing confidence in our commission and the actions we support.

2021 General Assembly Session – Unemployment Reforms Senate passed HB 6633

Reform Measures (take effect in 2024):

Employers

Unemployment is 2 parts:

- Part 1 Federal unemployment
 - Employers pay a flat rate of \$42.00 per employee
- Part 2 State unemployment
 - a) Each employer is billed based on this formula:

Experience Rate x Taxable Wage Base

- o Based on 3 variables
 - a) Taxable Wage Base (Raise the taxable wage base from \$15K to \$25K) No big lift for employers
 - b) Solvency Tax flat rate on all employers when and if the state reaches their solvency goal. (Reduce the maximum solvency tax rate from 1.4% to 1%) When lowered to 1% this means that when the solvency goal is not reached, every employer gets taxed the 1%. If the solvency goal is reached, it will drop to 0%, therefore no bill to employers
 - c) Experience Rate how much a business uses the unemployment fund/amount of layoffs (*Reduce the minimum and expand the maximum experience tax rate from 0.5-5.4% to 0.1-10%*) This change shifts the tax to the employers that use the fund more often. Example, seasonal employers that have large layoffs will be billed at a higher rate than year round employers who have lower amounts of layoffs. Overall outcome: 73% of businesses get a tax cut rather than an increase.

Employees

 (Increase the minimum base period earnings from \$600 to \$1,600) No longer allows employees that make less than \$1,600 in a tax year to apply for Unemployment benefits. Example, college students that work for the summer making only \$1,599 and return to school will no longer be able to collect unemployment benefits throughout the school year.

- (Freeze the maximum benefit amount for 4 years)
- (Defer unemployment benefits until a claimant's severance payments are exhausted)

<u>Other</u>

- Currently if an employee is a no show for 3 consecutive days, day 1 and 2 are considered **one** instance of misconduct, and day 3 is a **second** instance of misconduct. This causes employers to have to wait for one more instance of misconduct in order to terminate an employee with no option to collect unemployment benefits.
 - New reform changes this, so that each day of a no show counts as one instance of misconduct. Three days of no shows equals 3 instances of misconduct. This gives employers more ability to terminate employees without having to go through unemployment claim procedures.
