Applications are put on the agenda at random, using a computer application. A business application that is not complete is subject to the Committee's policy that incomplete applications will not be recommended.

Applications are scored according to written criteria established by the Town Council. Copies of the criteria will be available at the meeting. In order for the Committee to recommend an application from a non-profit, it must attain an average score of 75 or more out of 100. Applications from businesses must attain an average score of 70 or more.
