- WHEREAS, The proposed equipment will allow the Police Department to maintain the current radio system, and during a hostage or crisis management operation, communications will be tied into the system without breaching security.
- BE IT RESOLVED, That the Town Council authorizes the expenditure of (\$27,619) to purchase the two-way radio system. 28,619.
